### Tips For Seniors from the Ben Spec

#### An Important Benefit To Help Out With Grocery Costs

The United States Department of Agriculture operates an important program to help the people of Wisconsin with their food costs. The program is called FoodShare and is a federally funded agriculture and nutrition program that is administered by the State of Wisconsin. Benefits available under this program range from a minimum of around \$14 per month for eligible individuals on up, depending on household size and income.

Recently, federal legislation through the 2008 Farm Bill made many improvements to this already valuable program. The minimum benefit available has been fixed at \$10 for some time. Changes with this legislation have now increased this minimum monthly benefit to around \$14 and this amount will increase annually. Fourteen dollars may not sound like a lot but it can go a long way towards supplementing a monthly budget and allowing income to be used for other needs.

Eligibility for Wisconsin FoodShare is based on income. Households with income below the eligibility limit qualify for at least the minimum benefit. For a single person, that would be monthly income below \$1702 and for a couple, the limit is \$2282. Assets are not counted for FoodShare. Income limits are adjusted annually and will go up in October 2008. So, if your income is above that amount check back with your county or tribal benefit specialist to find out what the new eligibility numbers are and to see if you qualify.

Upon becoming eligible for FoodShare, program participants receive a card that looks just like a credit card. They can use this card at the grocery store to access their benefits. It works just like a debit card or a bank card. The card is "swiped" through the credit card machine for deductions from the monthly deposit. It is very easy to use and almost all stores that sell groceries participate in the program.

Remember, fall will bring the onset of those high heating costs and FoodShare may be just what the doctor ordered to help ease the strain on your monthly budget!

## A Look at The Law

A "riparian owner" is one whose land abuts navigable waters ("littoral owners" are those whose land abuts lakes - Wisconsin draws no distinction however).

Certain legal rights known as riparian rights vest in riparian owners such as the rights to erect docks and piers on their shorefront land. Riparians have the right to construct and use docks, piers, and boat slips, along with boating and swimming rights.

Any attempt to convey riparian rights apart from riparian land to a nonriparian directly, or by reservation of rights, or by an easement is prohibited by Section 30.133, Wis. Stats.. The only exception to this prohibition is the allowance to cross riparian land to access navigable water. The "right to cross" does not include any right to construct docks, piers, put any thing or structure into the water, and it does not include the use of a pier or boat slip within its definition.

Riparian rights are subject only to the Public Trust Doctrine which holds that the State of Wisconsin is trustee of navigable water beds for the full and reasonable use and enjoyment (including natural beauty) by the public.

Land ends at the ordinary high water mark (OHWM). When a person is beyond the OHWM, having exercised the "right to cross" on riparian land, the person may enjoy the navigable water, but this does not include the use of a riparian owner's dock and boat slips.
