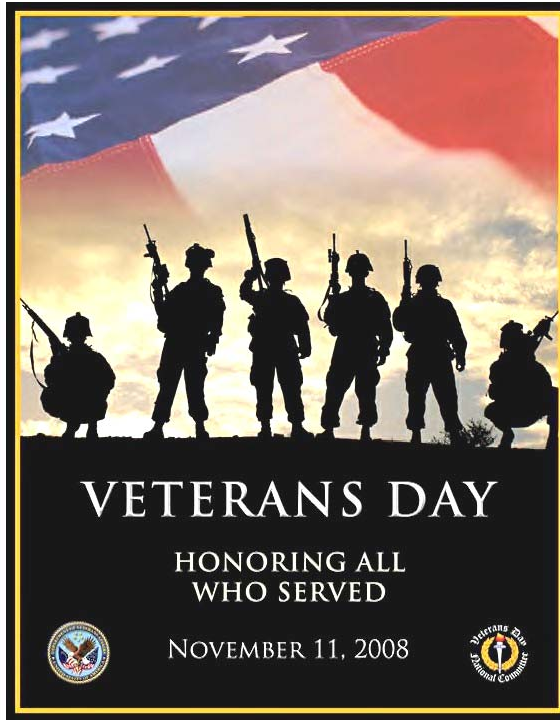

" In reference to the picture of the 1938 North Bend ball team in your 7 Oct. issue, yes, Oscar Kamprud was one of the children of Albert & Magnild Kamprud that endured that storm of 1930 that destroyed their farm buildings. Lester, the second to the youngest was one of my special friends for many years. We played ball together for North Bend in the '50s and '60s. Tommy Langston on that '38 picture was my uncle and his son Gale, who was known as "Buck", is the unknown one. Glen Johnson and Buddy Fillner still played with us in the '50s some of the time. I lived in North Bend the first 67 years of my life, then moved to Holmen in 1998.

I just discovered I can read your "Chat" online and would like to commend you for the great job you are doing. We really enjoy it.

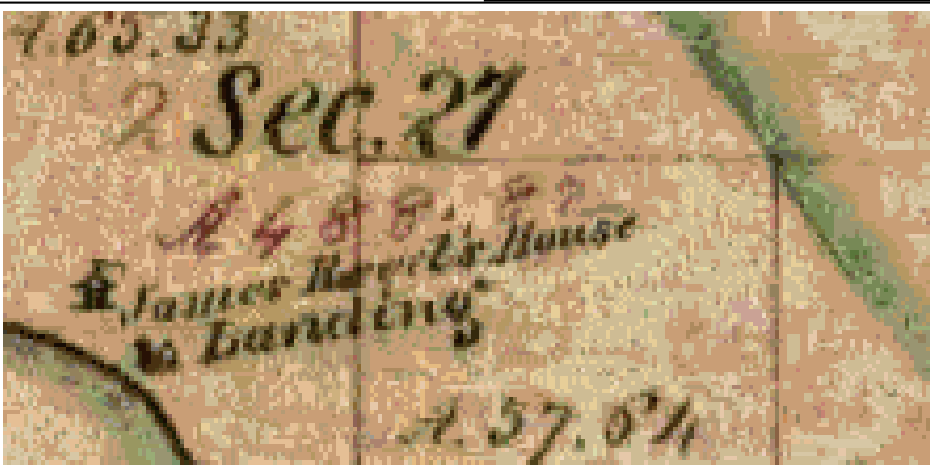
Does anyone know....

What is referred to as "a water power" and what would be the "cheapest improved water power"?

I received many comments on the meaning of "a water power" when advertising farm land for sale. They ranged from a windmill to water rights to a creek or a water wheel.

Then I ended pulling out a brochure I had gotten from Bill Finch who went to the Trempealeau Historical event with Ernie Boszhardt, and called him.

He said this wasn't his expertise, but his input was very educational. He felt that the verbiage in the ads may have been generated from the public land surveys/ When the government performed the land surveys, the surveyors came thru this area in the 1840's. One of their tasks was to establish value for certain purposes. When they came across a place that had rapids or places where you could build a dam, and essentially create a water fall, they were relatively valuable. Thus, they were noted either on the map or in the notes or the miscellaneous notes. So I guess you know what I'll be reading over the next couple of weeks. Can you help?

I am hoping with all the hunters and hikers around, someone just might be able to help.

When I was reading, I ran across this account by Stark Butman. I had certainly heard of the Snow family and the Butman family, but if I had known of this story, I had forgotten it.

"On a little knoll about a half mile from Hunter's Bridge, once stood, or maybe still stands a tombstone. It is described as a desolate spot, with oak scrubs around. " The year was 1853 and only one or two log huts stood on Decora Prairie. And less than a dozen could be found between the county line and La-Crosse. Mr. Snow lived in one of them. William Lincoln, a relative of the Snows, died when a young man. He was living with them at the time.

As there were few neighbors, when the boy died, Snow went to the cabin of Stark Butman. His log shanty stood on a 400 acre claim, later known as the Sacia farm. Stark knew a carpenter across the river, and together they built a coffin. Stark then carried it on his back to the river, taking it across in a 'skiff'. There Snow met him with a horse and wagon. They took the coffin to the Snow cabin and the remains were laid out. It was then placed in the wagon and the funeral party consisting of Mr & Mrs Snow, two daughters, a son, and Stark Butman, followed on foot to the burial plot. When Snow's wife died, she also was buried on the knoll, and another pioneer woman a few years later. Does anyone where this is???

New ForwardHealth,
SeniorCare and
Well Woman Cards
Arriving this November

If you receive benefits under BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program, Wisconsin Well Woman Program, or Medicaid you will soon receive a new member identification card. The new ForwardHealth, SeniorCare and Wisconsin Well Woman program cards replace all existing program cards. The most important change with your new card is the assignment of a new member identification (id) number. This new id number replaces the existing practice of using your Social Security Number (SSN) for identification purposes.

If you experience any problems with your new card during the changeover you can still use your old card. However, your current cards will eventually be deactivated after 30 days. Once your old card expires you should cut it up to protect your SSN. If you continue to experience problems with either card, you should give the provider your SSN and contact Member Services at 1-800-362-3002. Your providers are also receiving information and training about the new cards. If you are having problems with the new process or have questions, contact Becky Pomeroy, your local elderly benefit specialist at 877-538-2311 extension 249.

**Alzheimer's Awareness
Stamp Now Available**

According to the Alzheimer's Association, every 71 seconds, someone in America develops Alzheimer's disease. For these individuals and their families, the significance of this moment cannot be underestimated, as it marks the beginning of a devastating descent into memory loss. For the person with Alzheimer's, interaction with the caregiver means everything.

To raise awareness of issues surrounding this dreadful disease and to draw attention to the importance of the caregiver, the U.S. Postal Service will issue 65 million 42-cent Alzheimer's Awareness stamps nationwide beginning on Friday, Oct. 17.

Experts estimate that more than five million Americans are living with Alzheimer's disease. People suffering with Alzheimer's have trouble carrying out daily activities. The disease initially affects the parts of the brain that control language, thought and memory. It is the most common form of dementia among older people. To help recognize the warning signs, the Alzheimer's Association has developed a list of the 10 common symptoms of Alzheimer's disease:

- Alzheimer's: The Warning Signs**
1. Memory loss.
 2. Difficulty performing familiar tasks.
 3. Problems with language.
 4. Disorientation to time and place.
 5. Poor or decreased judgment.
 6. Problems with abstract thinking.
 7. Misplacing things.
 8. Changes in mood or behavior.
 9. Changes in personality.
 10. Loss of initiative.

With the issuance of the Alzheimer's Awareness stamp, the Postal Service continues its long-standing tradition of raising awareness of social issues. Recent stamps have highlighted important issues such as adoption and children's health, literacy, hospice care, breast cancer awareness, AIDS awareness, organ and tissue donation and philanthropy. The Breast Cancer Research stamp is a semipostal stamp authorized by Congress that helped raise funds for research. Social awareness stamps have helped generate conversation about these serious topics in communities from coast to coast. These activities go hand in hand with the Postal Service's historic role as a community leader.

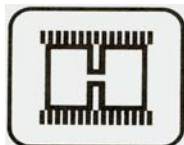
